I. TRAVIS AFB UPDATES

A. ADMINISTRATIVE

1. Agenda and Introductions

Travis RPM started the meeting and reviewed the agenda. They also noted that Ms. Kimiye Touchi from DTSC has moved to a new position within DTSC, and that Christopher Scudder would be taking on her responsibilities for Travis AFB.

2. Action Item Review (Attachment 2)

Travis RPM reported on the status of action items from the November 2023 RPM Meeting. Please see Attachment 2 for full briefing.

Ongoing Action Item 1: January 2024 Update: Travis RPM noted that they spoke with the ROICC regarding manifests and documentation of sampling and off-site disposal. Travis RPM presented the documents during the meeting and took the action to send the data electronically to the regulatory agency representatives. The team agreed that this action item can be closed once they receive the email from Travis RPM with the requested information.

3. Master Meeting and Document Schedule Review (see Attachment 3)

The Travis AFB Master Meeting and Document Schedule (MMDS) was discussed during this meeting (see Attachment 3).

Travis AFB Annual Meeting and Teleconference Schedule

The next RPM meeting is scheduled for 17 April 2024 at 1000, and the next Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) meeting is scheduled for 18 April 2024 at 1900. In order to make travel more efficient for the team, everyone agreed to move the RPM meeting date to 18 April ahead of the RAB. Travis RPM took the action to coordinate an appropriate start time for the RPM Meeting with Ms. Dunphy that will allow enough time for RAB meeting setup.

- Community Relations Plan (CRP) Update: There were no changes to the schedule.
- 2022 Annual Groundwater Remediation Implementation Status Report (GRISR): The Response to Comments and Final due dates were changed to 31 January 2024.
- 2022 Annual Site LF007 CAMU Inspection, Monitoring, and Maintenance Report: The Response to Comments and Final due dates were changed to 29 January 2024.
- Site LF006 Remedial Action Completion Report: There were no changes to the schedule.
- Subarea LF007C Groundwater Extraction System Optimization Technical Memorandum: This is a new document. The AF document lead will be Travis RPM. The contractor document lead will be Jacobs. - Five Year Review: The AF/USACE Review and Acceptance of Additional RTCs due date was changed to 19 January 2024; the remainder of the dates were changed accordingly The Five Year Review document has been sent to the Air Force for signature. Regulatory agency representatives stated that they would verify with their management if they are able to simultaneously start their own regulatory signature processes.

1. PFAS Update (Attachment 4)

Travis RPM reported on the PFAS updates for Travis AFB. Please refer to Attachment 4 for the full briefing.

2. LUC Updates (Attachment 5)

Travis RPM reported on the status of the LUC sites at Travis AFB. Please refer to Attachment 5 for the full briefing. Highlights of the discussion are as follows:

Travis RPM noted that the indoor air sampling planned for the KC-46 Hangar Project is part of the KC-46 construction project managed by the Navy. The construction project is outside of the ERP. Funding and contracting mechanisms to execute this work have not yet been identified. The regulatory agency representatives noted that when they said the building could be occupied as long as sampling is planned, they did not expect sampling to take this long and would like contact the Navy outlining their concerns. Travis RPM took the action to provide contact information to the regulatory agency representatives.

LUC Inspections are proposed to start on the RPM Placeholder Date of 21 February, which will likely take two days. Travis RPM proposed a tour of the KC-46 hangar with the regulatory agency representatives prior to the start of LUC inspections on 21 February. Travis RPM took the action to send an Outlook invitation to the regulatory agency representatives for the tour and LUC inspections.

II. OPTIMIZED REMEDIATION CONTRACT UPDATES

1. Program Update (Attachment 6)

Ms. Royer reported on the status of the Optimized Remediation Contract at Travis AFB. Please see Attachment 6 for the full briefing.

2. Groundwater Treatment Systems Update (Attachment 7)

Mr. Berwick reported on the status of the groundwater treatment systems at Travis AFB for October and November 2023. Please see Attachment 7 for the full briefing.

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Mr. Berwick provided an update outside of the October/November 2023 reporting period discussed during the presentation. He stated that cis-1,2 DCE was detected in the December 2023 effluent sample at a concentration in excess of the effluent limitation at the South Base Boundary Groundwater Treatment Plant (SBBGWTP). Confirmation samples (system effluent and upgradient and downgradient of the SBBGWTP outfall in Union Creek) were collected according to protocol and timeframe, and analytical results were received from the laboratory yesterday (1/16/2024). The results confirmed an exceedance in the system effluent. The carbon will be changed out to rectify the situation; the treatment system has been shut down and will not operate until the carbon has been changed out. Mr. Berwick has provided the data to the Travis RPM, who will provide it to the regulatory agency representatives.

III. SRS PFAS CONTRACT

A. ADMINISTRATIVE

All administrative topics were discussed earlier in the RPM meeting prior to the Oneida Team presentation.

B. PRESENTATIONS

Travis AFB Phase I RI of PFAS Sites – Program/Issues/Update (Attachment
 8)

Phase 1 Remedial Investigation Data-Driven Process

Ms. Duley presented a diagram illustrating the current progress and upcoming activities as part of the data-driven process for the Phase I RI. Data being generated from Field Event #3 is being integrated with previous field data for use in the ESS, CSM, and Phase I RI Report. Final laboratory results are coming in and the last data validation and usability evaluations are in progress. The Oneida

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Team is targeting a date of 29 January 2024 to provide the requested comprehensive data package (Excel file) including all RI field events. The Final Phase I RI Report is currently due in July 2025.

Current Status/Next Steps

Ms. Duley reminded the group that as discussed in previous RPM meetings, Oneida is happy to present the PFAS RI data collected thus far to the project team so everyone can take a look at results without waiting for the Draft Phase I RI report. The team decided that the presentation could be provided on 20 March 2024 during the RPM placeholder meeting time; Ms. Duley will send out a meeting invite.

Ms. Duley provided an update on the Current Status slide providing the dates for project milestones and completion of field work events.

Ms. Burke asked if the ESS report will be updated ahead of the Team's March meeting. Ms. Duley responded that the ESS will be updated/finalized prior to the RI report, but not in time for the meeting.

Ms. Duley continued speaking about Field Event #3. Eight lysimeters were installed and sampled in September 2023 and again January 2024. Ms. Burke asked if the Oneida Team would be able to provide an early indication of the lysimeter data. Ms. Duley said after receipt of results from at least two quarterly events, the Oneida Team could present the data at an RPM or other team meeting. Next steps for the project include CSM refinement, work on the ESS Tech Memo, and Phase I RI Report; these tasks have all been initiated. Ms. Duley showed a map summarizing the locations completed during Field Event #3.

Questions/Discussion

Mr. Santiago asked if the red well symbols shown on the map represented wells installed during RI field work. Ms. Duley responded yes, they were wells assigned to Field Event #2 whose installation was delayed while waiting for access agreements so they were completed in Summer 2023 prior to Field Event #3. Mr. Santiago asked if a clean map showing only monitoring wells could be provided to support communication with installation offices. Ms. Duley responded yes, and also clarified that the Oneida GIS data is regularly provided to Travis AFB in case they would like to generate their own maps for any reason or the Team can provide requested figures.



Current Status



- UFP-QAPP Addendum No. 2 submitted 28 APR 2023
- Regulatory Comment Resolution 27 JUL 2023
 - Relocation of one off-Base well pair incorporated into UFP-QAPP Addendum No. 2; Final version issued 27 July 2023.
- Completed Field Event #2 25 JUL 2023
 - Off-Base MW installation
 - 12 June 25 July 2023, installed 25 off-Base MWs
- Field Event #3 14 JUN 2023 23 OCT 2023
 - Completed 54 MWs, 21 on-Base and 33 off-Base
 - 32 source area soil borings and soil sampling; completed in September and October 2023
 - Groundwater sampling completed at 269 existing and newly installed MWs from July and October 2023





Current Status



Field Event #3 continued

- Lysimeter installation and sampling
 - Field Change Request #3 finalized 18 September 2023
 - Lysimeters installed 20-23 September 2023
 - Lysimeters sampled in October 2023
 - Second quarterly lysimeter sampling event in January 2024.

Data evaluation

- Boring logs and MW installation data provided to team member AECOM for the Environmental Sequence Stratigraphy (ESS) Evaluation – update targeted for Spring 2024.
- Field Event #3 data validation. Once data is finalized, a compiled data file will be provided to regulatory stakeholders (target January 2024).
 Oneida would like to schedule a meeting to review the project data to date (target February 2024).
- CSM development and Phase I RI Report






Field Event #3 Completed Locations
