Travis AFB hosts May 2022 Wings Over Solano Open House and Air Show

TRAVIS AIR FORCE BASE, Calif. – Travis AFB is hosting the 2022 Wings Over Solano Open House and Air Show May 14-15, 2022.

The two-day event is free and open to the public. The Hospital Gate opens for general admission access at 9 a.m. on both days of the event. Performances begin at 11 a.m. and end at 3 p.m.

Attendees can expect to see a variety of aerial and ground demonstrations.

Aerial demonstrations and flyovers include: Travis AFB's C-17 Globemaster III, KC-10 Extender and C-5M Super Galaxy aircraft; the F-35A Lightning II Demonstration Team; the U-2 Dragon Lady; Air Force Global Strike Command aircraft to include the B-2 Spirit and B-1B Lancer; and a variety of civilian performers such as the Patriot Jet Demo Team.

Other activities and attractions include: demonstrations by the 60th Aeromedical Evacuation Squadron and 60th Explosive Ordnance Disposal Team; flight simulators for the M-4 and KC-46A Pegasus; booths from Cal Fire, local police departments and Air Force Recruiting; as well as a kids' zone, STEM fair, and more.

The open house will display the pride, precision and professionalism represented by the Air Force and provide the community with opportunities to interact with the Airmen and assets that deliver hope and strength worldwide, every day.
