Site Name: Grazing Management Units (GMUs) 7 and 8

Site Description: GMUs 7 and 8 consist of gently sloping grassy pastures that were originally part of the former Fairfield Air Force Station. They comprise about 37 acres in the northwestern portion of the West/Annexes/Basewide Operable Unit in an undeveloped area of Travis AFB. GMU 8 is immediately south of GMU 7, separated by a barbed-wire fence. The site is bordered to the north by Ellis Drive and the Railhead Munitions Staging Area, to the west by the Weapons Storage Area, and to the south and east by other GMUs. After 1984, the Travis Saddle Club used GMUs 7 and 8 for grazing and exercising horses.

Selected Remedy: GMUs 7 and 8 have been investigated extensively in the 1980's and as part of the WABOU Remedial Investigation in 1995. No chemicals of concern were identified in any medium at this site. Therefore, no further action is necessary at GMUs 7 and 8.
