Site Name: Radioactive Burial Site #2

Site Description: The Low-Level Radioactive Burial Site #2 was a fenced, back-filled trench that once received waste materials from the nuclear material maintenance activities in Building 903. This was the only site on Travis AFB with elevated radioactive readings.

Selected Remedy: The West/Annexes/Basewide Operable Unit Soil ROD (CH2M HILL, 2002) selected Alternative S5 (Excavation/Off-base Disposal) to address the waste and contaminated soil in the trench. From October 16, 2002 to February 12, 2003, the Air Force conducted a cleanup action to excavate the waste materials and contaminated soil and transport them to a radioactive waste repository in Utah. The cleanup achieved residential cleanup levels, and the site was cleared for unrestricted use. The site is closed.
