

# HERE'S THE SCOOP






*When walking your dog, always carry a pooper scooper or plastic bag with you to pick up your pet's waste.*



Pet shampoos and soaps, even when biodegradable, can be toxic to humans or other animals which could be exposed to the waste water.






Wash pets indoors in a bathtub or sink using less toxic shampoos, or consider having your pet professionally groomed.
